Pave It Forward

WHAT: The *Pave It Forward* campaign is raising the funds needed to redesign and reconstruct the south parking lot. The longer we wait, the more extensive the repairs and cost.

WHY: The new lot will have increased handicapped accessibility, better lighting, and a smooth and safe surface, thereby creating a better entrance and exit experience.

WHEN: The campaign began in March and runs through June 2020, or until we achieve the campaign goal of \$175,000. As of April 15, we have pledges totaling just over \$100,000.

WHO: Everyone that visits Holy Cross will benefit because “Welcome” begins in the parking lot! The campaign is named *Pave It Forward* because a percentage of the money raised will be gifted to our partner church, Hephatha Lutheran, for the reconstruction of their bathrooms.

HOW: There are pledge cards available near the entrances and exits of church. The cards are sorted by vehicle type, with each vehicle representing a different giving commitment level, from \$50 to \$2000. Completed pledge cards can be placed in the *Pave It Forward* campaign boxes or returned to the church office. Donations toward your pledge can be made via Simply Giving, Text to Give, or cash/check using the yellow *Pave It Forward* envelopes near the pledge cards.

If you have not made a pledge or given a donation to the *Pave it Forward* campaign, please consider doing so. With everyone’s participation we will certainly meet our goal!
