2018-2019 Faith Development

It's time to register your children for the 2018-2019 Faith Development (FD) school year on May 6 & 20. Registration will be held in the hallway across from the Nativity cabinets. You will be able to pick up a copy and/or drop off your registration form. FD is for children ages three through sixth grade. Forms will be handed out in FD and are also available on a table outside of the church office. The cost is \$35 per child or \$85 for a family with more than two children.

Shipwrecked Vacation Bible School (VBS)...June 18-22

Send your kids on an exciting island adventure at Shipwrecked Vacation Bible School. VBS is for children ages three through sixth grade. Kids will discover how Jesus rescues them through life's storms. Shipwrecked VBS is filled with incredible Bible-learning experiences that kids see, hear, touch, and even taste!
