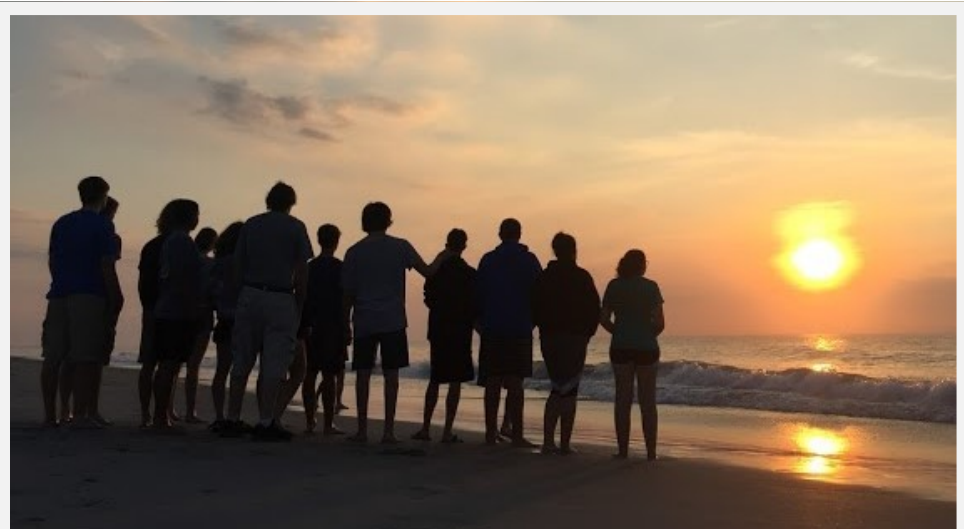

What's a vicar?

In American Lutheran churches, "Vicar" has a long history of being used as a title for those completing their full-time, year-long internships. These internships occur either in the third or fourth year of a student's four-year master's degree program. Unlike the word "Pastor", which in our church is both a title and a position, "Intern" is just the name of a position. Therefore, most congregations follow the model that they know: they use "Vicar" both as the title and the name of the position. That's what Holy Cross decided to do.

What do Vicars do? Vicars have been approved by their seminaries and by the ELCA to serve in any pastoral role that is not limited to the ordained. That is, they cannot preside over the sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion, but can preach, teach, lead worship, visit and console those in need, administer programs, and do many other things. Depending on the growth areas of the vicar and the needs of the congregation, the year of learning in a parish can look very different.

How did Vicar Hans come to be at Holy Cross? After discussion with the Council, Staff, and Synod, Holy Cross applied to serve as an internship site with the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago. Through an interview and discernment process, both Pastor Meredith and Vicar Hans felt as if the Holy Spirit was calling them to work together. Due to this call sensed by both parties, LSTC assigned Vicar Hans to serve at Holy Cross.

Are vicars paid? Vicars receive a stipend, set by the ELCA, to pay their necessary expenses and to purchase health insurance. In addition to this, vicars receive housing from the congregation.

How long will Vicar Hans be here? Vicar Hans will serve for one calendar year at Holy Cross, from July 15, 2017 to July 14, 2018.

What's next? With God's help, Vicar Hans and his wife Vicar Marissa will be assigned to one of the ELCA's 65 synods after they complete their year-long internship. After receiving a call in the synod to which they have been assigned, they will be ordained as pastors by that synod's

bishop. Holy Cross will, in all likelihood, be assigned another vicar by LSTC, should both parties wish to continue the agreement. This vicar will begin shortly after Vicar Hans' departure on July 14.
