### Dear Disciples of Holy Cross,

Last weekend we celebrated Zac Meyer's nine years among us. During this time, we saw the transformation of our confirmation and youth ministries. Our ability to attract and retain gifted staff like Zac is made possible by your offerings.

Many of you have inquired *what is next* in filling the position of Minister of Youth Faith Formation. This position has grown to include preaching, teaching, lifting up small group relationships and inspiring our young people to service. An ideal candidate would have theological training, public speaking proficiency and a passion for inspiring young people and young adults in faith and service. It is essential the candidate relate to young people and their parents/guardians, while understanding the culture, pressures and challenges that surround them.

Our plan is to call a pastor or theologically trained lay person to serve in this specialized area of ministry. We have eight people ready to serve on a Call Committee to begin the process in January.

Although we are excited about this possibility, let us share our concern. Like other churches, Holy Cross typically operates with a deficit throughout the first ten months of the year, anticipating that the usual year-end up-turn in giving will offset the deficit. However, in the month of November we experienced a sharp and unexpected decline of \$25,000 in offerings.

Although we have underspent our budget by 5%, as of November 30 we have a deficit of \$86,708. Presently, the new youth pastor position is included in the proposed 2018 budget, but we feel unable to move forward unless the 2017 deficit is significantly reduced.

God works through all of us to make ministry happen. Please consider additional offerings during December so that we can begin the new year in a strong financial position.
