We are pleased that Pastor Meredith and Pastor Mary Martha from Hephatha will co-facilitate this year's retreat. Nurse Louise and our friends from Hephatha will also join us!

We will enjoy hotel style accommodations at Green Lake Conference Center, a beautiful 1000 acre retreat center on the shores of Green Lake, about 1 1/2 hours from Holy Cross. Room rates shown below include three meals and all linens. Yes, the rates have been raised this year at the Center but it is an experience well worth it!

This year, room rates will vary based not only on number of occupants but also on room type – some suites (which are larger and include a sleeper sofa) will be available at a slightly higher rate. ### Youth 144 Envelope Campaign

**What, Why and Who:** Holy Cross youth will be attending the ELCA Youth Gathering in Houston from June 26-July 2, 2018. This event happens every 3 years. While in Houston, our teens will gather with 30,000 ELCA high school students from across the country for interactive learning, Bible study, worship, service and fellowship. This is a life changing opportunity for our youth to grow their faith in amazing ways! The cost for the Houston trip is \$1250-\$1500 per person. Our 144 Envelope Campaign will help students with this cost.



#### How can you get involved in our 144 Envelopes Campaign?

You take an envelope from the display in the atrium and place the dollar amount of the envelope inside and return to the church office or in the offering plate on Sunday. It's that easy!!! For example: If you take envelope 43, you will return the envelope with \$43 inside. Your donations will decrease the cost of the trip for our students and help cover the cost for our chaperones. If every envelope is committed to and returned, it will reduce each student's trip cost by just over \$300, which is a huge help to families.
