2018-2019 Faith Development Registration

Don't forget to register your children ahead of time for the 2018-2019 Faith Development (FD) school year which begins on September 9. FD is for children ages three through sixth grade. You can either mail a check to Holy Cross to Sue's attention or pay online with a credit card. Go to the tab "Giving" then click on "Online Giving" to get started. The cost is \$35 per child or \$85 for a family with more than two children.
