Memorial Tribute

The program will consist of the laying of a wreath at the base of the Menomonee Falls WWII and War Dog monuments. The Menomonee Falls Gold Star list will be read. The program will end with a rifle salute and the playing of taps. A program will be provided at the event with additional information including various pictures of our fallen heroes.

It is also important to note that this year is the 70th anniversary of the building of the Menomonee Falls WWII monument by the AMVETS Post #5. We will have the only remaining monument builder present during the ceremony. The program is sponsored by Henrizi-Schneider American Legion Post #382, Walter Miller AMVETS Post #5, VFW Post #9496 and the War Dog organization.
