Community Service Day Reflection

Last Saturday 150 volunteers of all ages spent their morning serving in Menomonee Falls and the greater community as part of our Holy Cross Community Service Day. Collectively we logged over 400 hours of service! The story of Community Service Day is about more than the numbers; it's about the experiences and relationships that were built across all generations with people who are different from us...to walk alongside them in their mission.

~At our Angelman's Walk service site, Deatrice, who is a teenager from Hephatha with Angelman's Syndrome, led our group of Hephatha and Holy Cross walkers on a 2-mile journey through Hoyt Park. We walked with Deatrice in support and solidarity.

~Our folks at Just One More Ministry moved thousands of pounds of fresh produce and food that was recently donated by the Bradley Center as they prepare to close. The group learned about the homeless shelters, food pantries and soup kitchens that would be able to utilize the food.

~Our team who volunteered at All Peoples Harambee Campus painted a classroom that was damaged by leaky boiler pipes. They pulled weeds in the garden and helped prepare the site for the growing season. A growing season that gives out over 600 pounds of fresh produce to the community.

~Our team who partnered with ERAs Senior Programs completed yardwork for 2 ladies in their 90's and sat down to chat and enjoy treats with them.

These are just a few of the many stories from our Holy Cross Community Service Day. Thank you to the Glocal Team, Staff, Small Group Leaders, Kitchen Angels and volunteers who made it possible.
