Holy Cross Mission Endowment Grants

Annual distributions by the Mission Endowment Board are made available at the end of each calendar year. This money comes from previous gifts to the Mission Endowment Fund and the interest this account accrues. Each year five percent of the fund is given to three areas: ELCA church wide ministries, the local community and initiatives within Holy Cross. The total given in 2016 was \$8,750.

We are encouraging individuals and organizations to apply for these funds. If you know of such an individual or organization please pick up an application form in the church office. The deadline for application is December 1. Once the applications are received we will review them and award typically between \$500 and \$2,000 to the recipients, based on our by-laws and merit as determined by our Board.

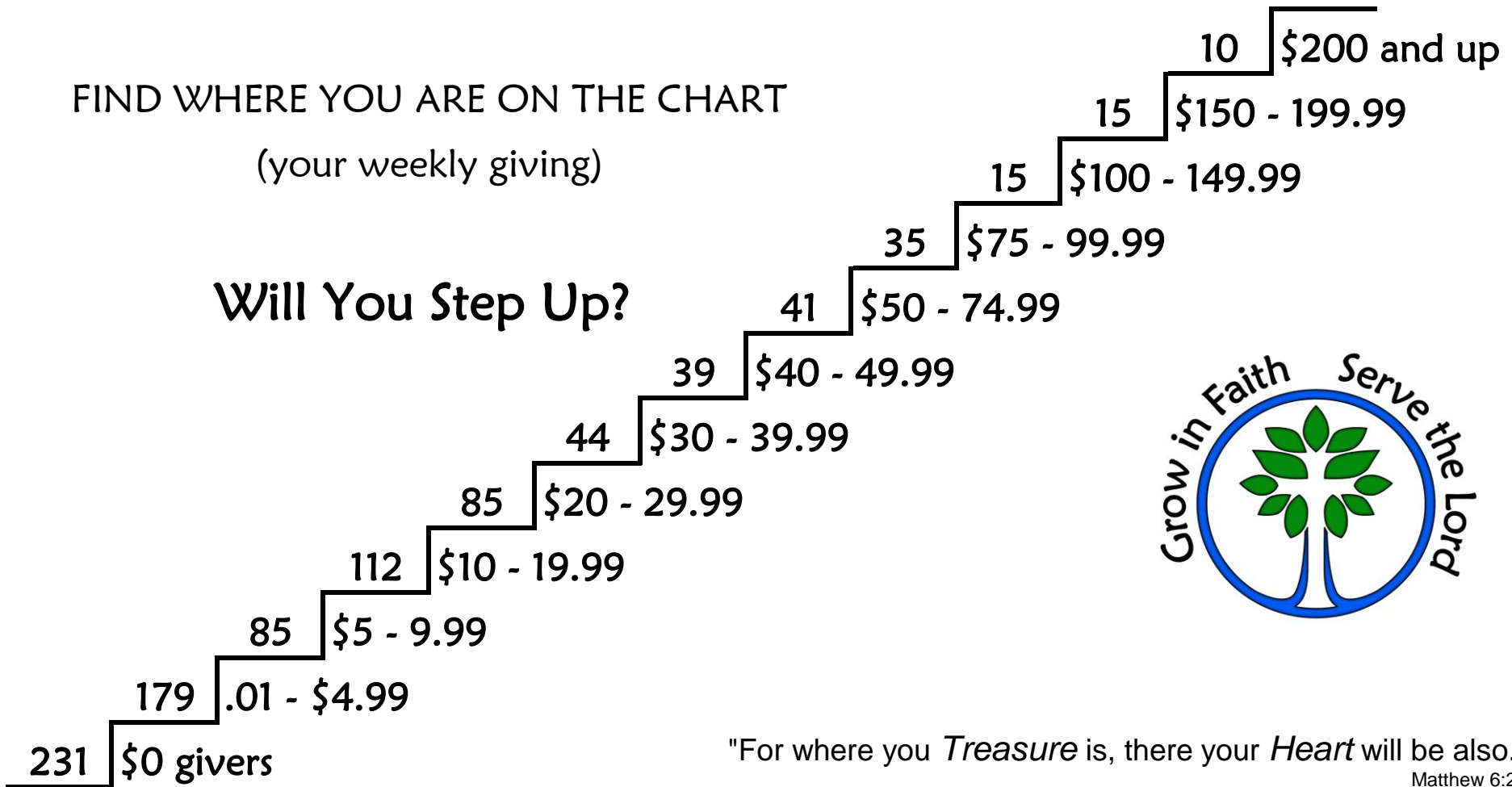

Example narrative to navigate the giving matrix:

John and Jane average weekly giving per their August statement is \$20. John and Jane determined their average monthly income to be \$4,800. Using the "Income" columns on the left and locating the number closest to \$4,800, they followed the corresponding line to the right to find the amount closest to their \$20 weekly giving. From this point, John and Jane determined they were at approximately 2.0%. At this giving range John and Jane reflected on their support of the various missions of Holy Cross and decide to increase their weekly giving by \$10 to \$30. Which increased their giving to an approximate 3.0% giving level . . . and enabled them to continue supporting Holy Cross.
