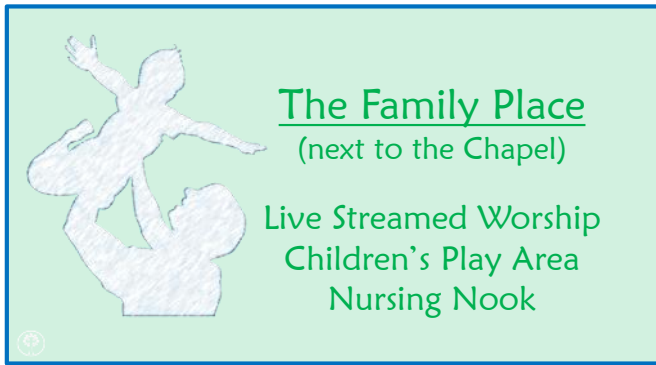

### **New Recycling Receptacles at Holy Cross**

My name is Jalysa Rivera and I am a member of Holy Cross. I will be confirmed at Holy Cross on October 27, 2019. I am also a Senior Girl Scout in Troop 4582 and have chosen recycling for my Silver Award project. I am hoping you will help me! I have purchased seven (7) new recycling containers for use at Holy Cross. There are four (4) smaller bins to be used for paper, cardboard and magazines. Some of these will be placed near the Sanctuary doors at the front and back exists. Please use these for any handouts or other printed paper that you feel you no longer need. There will be laminated signs above these containers as a reminder.

Recycling is very important. Waste has a huge negative impact on nature. Harmful chemicals and greenhouse gases are released from garbage in landfills. Recycling helps to reduce the pollution caused by waste and reduces the need for new raw materials. It also helps to protect the rainforests.

There will be two new, large recycling cans with covers placed in the Gathering Place and Trinity Center Kitchens. These containers are for all recyclable materials, including cans, bottles (plastic and glass), office paper and cardboard. Please empty and rinse any plastic or glass containers or bottles prior to disposing of them. Place the cover back on the container to help keep pests in check. There are existing trash containers in each kitchen for non-recyclable trash – gum, candy or food wrappers, Styrofoam cups or food. Do not toss these type of items into the recycling containers.

A third large recycling container can be found next to the soda machine by the Youth Room and Trinity Center Kitchen. Please empty and toss aluminum cans only in this container.

I believe we as Christians have a duty to respect the beautiful earth that God has given us and to keep it healthy and clean for the generations that follow us.
